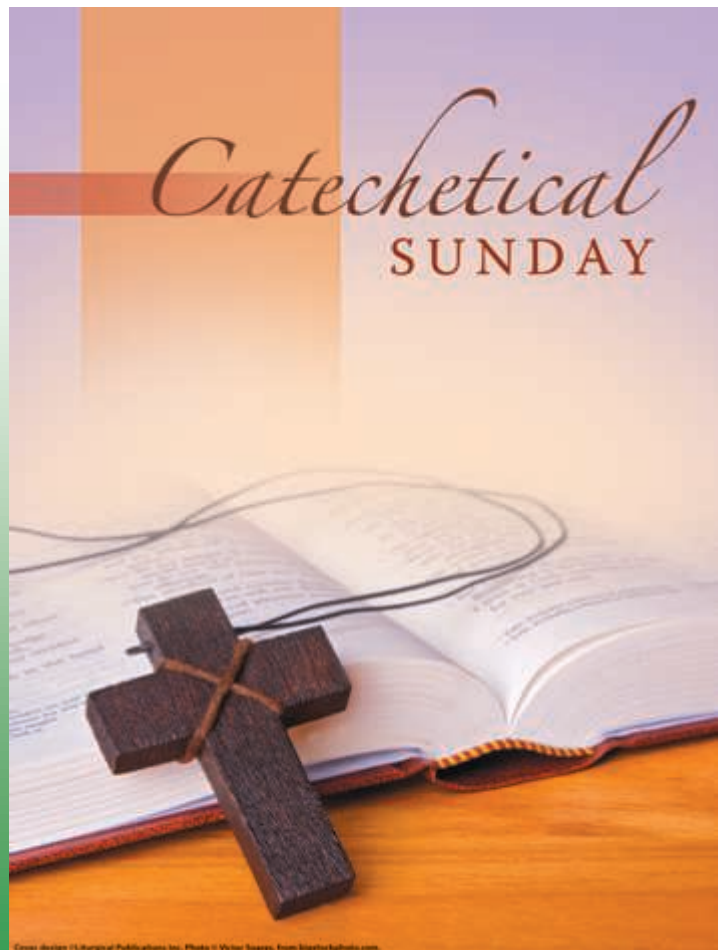

- Reconciliation

The Sacrament of Penance is offered every Saturday from 2:30-3:15 pm.

- Baptisms

Baptisms are conducted on the first Sunday for each month. Registered parishioners **must complete the Baptismal Preparation Class prior to their child's baptism**. It is recommended to take this class at least 3 months prior to the birth. To reserve your place in class, please contact Rosalynn Redmond in the Religious Education Office (913) 378-2700 , Monday-Friday from 9:00 am - 5:00 pm, after hours please leave a message, or send an email to: rosallynn@qhr-opks.org. **Your child's Baptismal date will be scheduled upon completion of this class.** This is a requirement for your first child and we invite you to attend the class for each child hereafter as a refresher course. To share in the beauty and preparation for this Sacrament, it is highly recommended, but not required, for **your child's Baptismal Godparents to attend this class with you.**

The fire inspector for Overland Park made his yearly visit this month. (Sept. '09) They do a wonderful job of keeping us up to date on what we need to do to keep all the buildings safe. We keep the fire extinguishers current, we have installed 2 defibrillators in the church, one at the top of the stairs outside the vesting sacristy and one in the hall on the east wall, above the fire extinguisher. The steps to the choir loft meet code. HOWEVER, they did mention that the chairs by the South and North doors at the front of the church crowd the exit aisles. They requested that we rearrange and move the chairs to other locations to maintain the number of seats, but open up those exit aisles. You will notice that the chairs by the handicapped ramp on the South side of the Altar have been reduced from 3 chairs to 2. I always want to keep you up to date on any changes and the reason for them.
