Tuition and Fees

Queen of the Holy Rosary Registered Parishioners

\$55.00 per family with 1 child

\$75.00 per family with 2 children

\$95.00 per family with 3 or more children

If your child is preparing for a Sacrament (Reconciliation, First Communion or Confirmation), there is an additional \$30.00 sacrament fee per child added onto the tuition. (This fee of materials, retreats, workshops and receptions).



Out of Parish Participating Families

\$80.00 per family with 1 child

\$100.00 per family with 2 children

\$120.00 per family with 3 or more children

If you child is preparing for a sacrament (Reconciliation, First Communion or Confirmation), there is an additional \$45.00 sacrament fee per child added onto the tuition. (This fee helps to defray the costs of materials, retreats, workshops and receptions).

Program Overview



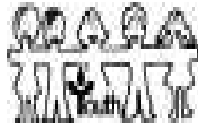
Parents are the principal and first Religious Educators of their children. (CCC1653).

Queen of the Holy Rosary Parish Religious Education program is a wonderful way to supplement your child's spiritual formation. Together—Parents, Catechists, and the Parish—we are here to support you in our joint responsibility to raise faith-filled and knowledgeable Catholics and to further the teachings of Jesus Christ and the Catholic Church.

We meet on Sunday mornings and Sunday evenings. Tuition is charged for the students to attend. Students who are preparing to receive a Sacrament will also have a Sacrament Fee. Copies of Baptismal certificates must be on file in the Religious Education office for all students. Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion are made in 2nd grade with Confirmation being celebrated in 8th grade. Sacraments are prepared for with Queen of the Holy Rosary Parish students who attend both John Paul II elementary and our parish School of Religion Program.

Sunday Mornings

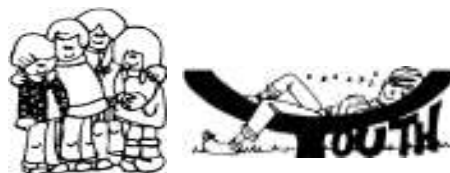
Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, level I, is offered as the Preschool program for School of Religion. Students who participate in preschool are involved in a Montessori approach to learning. They meet in the Atrium, the room where the Catechist and children work together. The prepared environment contains materials that are models of things used in the Church's worship.

Kindergarten— 5th Grades

Sunday Mornings

10:15—11:30 a.m.

Students who are enrolled in the public school system in Kindergarten though 5th grade participate in a structured classroom environment with textbooks. All classes are held in John Paul II elementary school. Course of study is guided by the Outcomes for the Religious Education Program by grade level and are the minimum of what your child should be taught by the end of each grade level. These outcomes are developed by the Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas.



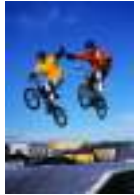
Class Descriptions

Junior High Program

Sunday Evenings

6:15—7:30 p.m.

Our Junior High program is a 3-year program, and consists of students who are in the 6th, 7th, and 8th grades in the public school system.



- 6th grade: Study of the Bible. The bible is a collection of many books (Law, Historical, Wisdom and Prophetic Books). The students study the roots of Jewish spirituality in our prayers, sacraments and liturgy by studying both the Old and New Testament.
- 7th grade: studies the Life of Jesus and the personal qualities of Jesus in scripture, as a man of prayer, as servant, and shepherd. They also begin the 1st year of their 2-year Confirmation Preparation.
- 8th grade: in order to understand where we are going, we need to understand where we have been. The 8th graders study not only history of the church, but also how the Holy Spirit guides us in discovering and living out our vocations. They are in their 2nd year of Confirmation preparation and attend additional monthly Confirmation classes with their sponsors on top of their Sunday evening class schedule.
